WINE LIST (BY THE BOTTLE)

Non Alcoholic Wine

1. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% Sparkling, Semi-Seco (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Muscat*
 - *Tasting Notes: Beautiful golden yellow color and a nice subtle bubble. The full notes of tropical fruit, vanilla and apricots and the slightly sweet aftertaste.*

2. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% White Muscat (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Muscat*
 - *Tasting Notes: A pale yellow wine which offers seductive aromas of white flowers and fresh fruit (quince, Guyot pear). The palate is warm, silky and very flavourful.*

3. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% Garnacha-Syrah (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Garnacha Syrah Blend*
 - *Tasting Notes: Enjoy a lovely cherry-red wine, with aromas of pomegranate and currant, and hints of oak-imparted vanilla and toast. Round, balanced and truly clean on the palate with soft tannins and delicate acidity.*

SPARKLING WINE

1. **Sartori - Prosecco BRUT "Love Story" DOC NV (11%)** \$70
 - 100% Glera
 - *Tasting Notes: Straw yellow in colour with light-green hues. Fruit bouquet, reminiscent of wild apples and acacia flowers. The palate is comprised of citrus, orange blossoms and stone fruits. Fresh citrus and floral notes linger on the finish*

CHAMPAGNE

1. **Gratiot & Cie Almanach N°2 Brut NV (Champagne, 12%)** \$130
 - 68 % Pinot Meunier, 28 % Chardonnay, 4 % Pinot Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: An intense and aromatic nose combining fineness and complexity. The aromas of dried and candied fruit give it a fine lightness in mouth and a long finish.*
2. **Champagne Delamotte - Blanc de Blancs – NV** \$170
 - 100% Chardonnay
 - *Tasting Notes: This wine offer classy bouquet of crisp green apple, citrus oil, brioche, toasted nuts and dried white flowers. On the palate, the wine is medium to full-bodied, fine-boned and elegant, with a crisp but charming core of fruit, lively acids and a precise, saline finish.*
3. **Champagne Augustin Cuvée Cci Feu Blanc De Noir 1er Cru Vintage 2013** \$180
 - 100% Pinot Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: This Champagne is energetic and very harmonious sparkling wine. The wine is warm, radiant, expressive and sometimes unpredictable. Fresh, powerful and exciting, with a savory and mineral vein. Balanced and harmonious*
4. **Krug Grande Cuvée 169ème Édition champagne** \$380
 - 43% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay and 22% Meunier.
 - *Tasting Notes: A light golden colour and fine, vivacious bubbles, holding a promise of pleasure. Aromas of flowers in bloom, ripe, dried and citrus fruits, as well as marzipan and gingerbread. Flavours of hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar, jellied and citrus fruits, almonds, brioche and honey.*

SAKE

- 1. Hanagaki Junmai Nigori (Fukui, 720ml)** \$70
 - 14%, Polishing 65%, SMV -20
 - *Tasting Notes: Aromas of rice, porridge and coconut cream with a fruity, textured palate. A good harmony of acidity, sweetness and umami, and along, lingering finish.*

- 2. Miyasaka Miyama Nishiki Junmai Ginjo (Nagano, 720ml)** \$90
 - 15%, Polishing 55%, SMV +2
 - *Tasting Notes: Cornerstone of the Miyasaka series. Showcases number 7's gentle all-round flavor & clean acidity using Miyama Nishiki sake rice. Association No. 7 yeast is characterized by a mild flavor and fresh acid. It is a flagship product of the series*

- 2. Tanaka Manatsuru Tokubetsu Junmai Miyamanishiki (Miyagi, 720ml)** \$100
 - 15%, Polishing 60%, SMV unpublished
 - *Tasting Notes: A gentle ginjo sake-like scent. Refreshing and sharp taste.*

- 3. Nanbubijin Junmai Daiginjo Sake-Mirai Tenkei (Iwate, 720ml)** \$120
 - 16%, Polishing 50%, SMV +1
 - *Tasting Notes: Delicate and velvety textured Sake with full of fruity aroma, rich Umami, with an acidity light and refreshing finish. The label is designed by image of crystal of powdery snow falling down from heaven.*

- 4. Umenoyado Unfeigned junmai Daiginjo Namazake Cuvee (Nara, 720ml)** \$120
 - 16%, Polishing 50%, SMV +1.5 (**SEASONAL**)
 - *Tasting Notes: Gorgeous aroma and sweetness unique to Junmai Daiginjo Sake, and it has a high-quality, clean and crisp taste. We named it Cuvee, which means "special" because of our commitment to luxury.*

- 5. Hakkaisan Yukimuro Snow Aged 3 Year Junmai Daiginjo (Niigata, 720ml)** \$130
 - 17%, Polishing 50%, SMV N/A (**SEASONAL**)
 - *Tasting Notes: The nose on this sake that was aged in a traditional cooler that uses snow for year-round temperature control is a chill collection of melon, green apple, powdered sugar, citrus, Asian pear, and floral aromas. Smooth, round, viscous, and chewy, this full-bodied sake is layered, complex, and drinks like an open mouth snowflake catch. Look for lush deep flavors like nougat, cooked apple tart, pear confit, honeydew, and apricot tones.*

- 6. Hakkaisan "Tokubetsu Junmai Genshu" (Niigata, 720ml)** \$110
 - 17.5%, Polishing 55%, SMV 0 (**SEASONAL**)
 - *Tasting Notes: Hakkaisan Tokubetsu Junmai Genshu stands out for its light, but deep, flavor. Slowly fermenting the mash at low temperature gives this Sake a full-body and elegant bouquet. Retaining its full flavor and refreshing scent when chilled.*

WHITE WINE

1. **La Mora Vermentino di Toscana DOC 2020 (Maremma Tuscany, 12.5%)** \$70
 - *Vermentino 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Fresh & fragrant with aromas of stone fruit & pineapple with bright, succulent flavors of white peach, ripe pear & lime zest. It carries hints of succulent tropical fruits, mature pulp & a fresh & fragrant style, with a pleasant minerality*

2. **Peter Zemmer - Chardonnay Alto Adige DOC 2021 (Alto Adige, 13.5%)** \$100
 - *Chardonnay 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Pale lemon in color with lemon-green hues. Delicate, characteristic, with fresh aromas of citrus, melons, & tropical fruits. It tastes fresh & lively with hints of pineapple, pear, citrus & hint of nuts*

3. **Domaine Regis Jouan – Sancerre 2021 or similar (Upper Loire Valley, 12.5%)** \$100
 - *Sauvignon Blanc 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Sophisticated & stylish, the Jouan has all the classic lemon, citrus & star-fruit notes as well as a heavenly hint of flowers. With a racy, white grapefruit palate & tart, dry lemon on the finish*

4. **Domaine Ellevin Chablis 1er Cru "Vaucoupin" 2020 (Burgundy, 13%)** \$110
 - *Chardonnay 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Beautiful citrus, pear & Mirabelle plum aromas, complemented by a pleasant touch of minerality. Superb texture. Fleshy mouth dominated by citrus. Oily, coated, almost unctuous finish*

5. **Chateau Meursault – Clos du Chateau Blanc 2020 (Bourgogne, 13%)** \$130
 - *Chardonnay 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Light & slightly chalky on the nose. The palate is ripe on the entry with a brush of honey with a pleasant salinity towards the finish*

ROSE

1. **Frank Cornelissen SUSUCARU® Rosato 2020 (Sicilia, 11.5%)** \$110
 - *Malvasia, Moscadella, Cattaratto, Nerello Mascalese*
 - *Tasting Notes: Rosè (Rosato) "Susucaru" is a blend of old grapes grown on Etna. Skin contact maceration for texture and territorial identity, malolactic fermentation fully finished for density, fluidity and stability. Not only a refreshing summer wine from a blend of Malvasia, Moscadella, Insolia and Nerello Mascalese, as this is a "rosé" which can also be regarded as a light red, like a "Jura" wine, pairing well with a wide variety of dishes.*

RED WINE from FRANCE

- 1. Cotes Catalanes - Infiniment de l'Ou 2016 (Languedoc-Roussillon, 14%)** \$140
 - 100% Syrah
 - *Tasting Notes: Vinified & aged in barrel, its deep black/purple color is followed by a fabulous bouquet of cassis, smoked herbs, graphite & cured meats. Ripe, sexy, unctuous & layered, with moderate acidity & sweet tannin*

- 2. Marquis de Mons - Margaux - 2014 (Bordeaux, 13.5%)** \$120
 - 55% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot
 - *Tasting Notes: Dense, dark garnet color, drawing on purple in its youth. On the palate, this wine perfectly integrated their tannins in their structure, giving roundness. The aromas of the nose are black fruits & tertiary flavors include leather, vanilla. The wine style tends towards the balance, with supple tannins & good aromatic expression*

- 3. Domaine Boucabeille Les Orris Rouge 2015 (Côtes du Roussillon, 14%)** \$140
 - 70% Syrah, 30% Grenache Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: Deep purple/ ruby colour with impeccably clean notes of black raspberries and cassis intermixed with notions of new leather, pepper and scrub bush. Full bodies, elegant and seamless, with beautiful and fine tannins.*

- 4. Domaine Digoia-Royer Savigny Les Beaune Dessus Les Vermots 2019 (Cote de Beaune, 13.5%)** \$160
 - 100% Pinot Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: . It has a brisk, red cherry and raspberry-scented bouquet with a light marine influence that unfolds delicately with aeration. The palate is medium-bodied with ripe tannin, crisp blackberry and raspberry notes, and displays commendable weight in the mouth.*

- 5. Chateau Fombrauge – St. Emilion Grand Cru Classé 2007 (Bordeaux, 13%)** \$150
 - 77% Merlot, 9% Cabernet Sauvignon and 14% Cabernet Franc
 - *Tasting Notes: Fully mature, medium bodied, with a truffle, licorice, herb and black cherry personality.*

- 6. Chateau Phelan Segur - Saint Estephe - 2012 (Bordeaux, 13%)** \$180
 - 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc
 - *Tasting Notes: Dense, ruby/purple color, sweet blueberry and blackcurrant fruit, background earth and spice, with moderate, velvety tannins. This medium-bodied wine has good fruit, ripeness and a rather classic mouthfeel.*

RED WINE from ITALY

1. **La Marchesana, Primitivo IGT 2020 (Puglia 14%)** \$70
 - *Primitivo 100%*
 - *Tasting Notes: The aromas of cherry compote & red groats pour out of the glass. In the background the smoky notes of bacon & black olive. Slight hint of chocolate, vanilla & sage, on the palate completed by gentle tannins & a mild acidity*

2. **Villa Cerna Chianti Classico DOCG Riserva 2016 (Tuscany, 14%)** \$120
 - *Sangiovese 95%, Colorino 5%*
 - *Tasting Notes: Floral aromas with harmony balance between acidity, tannins and alcohol*

3. **Villa Matta Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG 2018 (Veneto, 14.5%)** \$130
 - *70% corvina veronese, 20% rondinella, 5% molinara, 5% others*
 - *Tasting Notes: An opulent wine of the classic Verona tradition. Red ruby color with garnet highlights. Very fruity with hints of cherry, black cherry and wild berry fruit. The mouth has a good structure with juicy fruit derived from the maceration on skins of Amarone. The tannin is soft and velvety.*

4. **Giacomo Fenocchio Barolo DOCG 2017 (Piemonte, 14.5%)** \$140
 - *100% Nebbiolo*
 - *Tasting Notes: Deep ruby red color with lively, bright softened by slight traces of purple. It has an intense, ethereal bouquets with the bitterish flavour of liquorice, witered roses & tarm alongside beady, warm and spicy aromas*

5. **Occhipinti Il Frappato 2019 (Sicilia, 12.5%)** \$140
 - *100% Frappato di Vittoria*
 - *Tasting Notes: Frappato aged for 14 months in Slavonia oak barrels and 2 months in the bottle, but it is not filtered, the palate is fleshy, juicy, sun, and fresh with a pleasant mineral finish. Frappato is flowers, herbs and tobacco. Frappato is Arianna. Frappato is Vittoria.*

6. **Lungarotti Sagrantino di Montefalco DOCG 2017 (Umbria, 15.5%)** \$140
 - *100% Sagrantino*
 - *Tasting Notes: A red wine with great richness in polyphenols. Deep and intense purple-red colour with a complex bouquet of red fruits, marasca cherry, currant and raspberry, as well as delicate notes of sweet tobacco and cocoa, finishing off with hints of officinal herbs. The structure is dense with rich but harmonious tannins and wonderful complexity; the fruitiness is sustained by fresh acidity and the finish is long-lasting.*

7. **Tenuta Di Sesta Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 2016 (Toscana, 14.5%)** \$150
 - *100% Sangiovese (Grosso)*
 - *Tasting Notes: Colour ruby red towards garnet with ageing. Scent intense, broad bouquet, elegant, rich in scents of mellow red fruits, spicy in notes of licorice and tobacco. Taste dry, warm, soft with velvet tannins, balanced, very intense, very persistent and elegant*

8. Querciabella Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG 2015 (Toscana, 14%) \$150

- 100% Sangiovese
- *Tasting Notes: Brilliant ruby-red. Aromas of violet, ripe cherries, earth, oak and a touch of incense. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and powerful and enriched with rosemary notes. Well-integrated tannins, great texture and excellent freshness. Very long finish with a hint of iron.*

9. Rubinelli Vajol Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2013 (Veneto, 16%) \$180

- *Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella, Molinara, Oseleta*
- *Tasting Notes: Medium garnet colour. Straight out of the glass, concentrated aroma of dried strawberry, supported by notes of espresso, dark chocolate, cinnamon, raspberry jam as well as balsamic vinegar and sour dark cherry. This Amarone is perfectly dry, with refined tannins, a high level of alcohol and a full body. Long elegant finish.*

RED WINE from AUSTRALIA

1. Izway Wines Bruce Shiraz 2017 (Barossa Valley 14.9%) \$160

- 100% Shiraz
- *Tasting Notes: The wine is intensely aromatic pure and fresh. The bright red fruits flow into cinnamon, spice, clove and cherry. The palate is initially structural and spicy, with the added Eden Valley component complementing the Barossa Shiraz perfectly. After decanting, the wine evolves into a rich and textural beast, with silky smooth ripeness supported by fine, grainy tannin.*
